- Waterside Custody suite will now have <u>four</u> bespoke vulnerability cells. Discreet separate booking in facility. Consideration around internal finishing with regard to Autism and being more Trauma Informed in design.
- Attendance at Trauma Informed Environments seminar by QUB and Trauma Informed Oregon
- Consideration currently being given to <u>next</u> new Custody Suite, with a focus on the design stage and potential for a <u>separate</u> bespoke children and young persons cell block
