

## **Appendix 14 – The Impact of Trauma for Refugees and Asylum Seeking Families**





These slides were codesigned with EA's Vulnerable Person's Relocation Scheme and are designed to discuss the potential impact of trauma for those seeking refuge or asylum, as well as specific adversities related to countries affected by war. It is recommended that these slides are incorporated into the Level 2 training between slides 19 & 20. This leads into the complex area of resilience building on slides 20-23.

## Appendix 15 – Children with complex needs or special educational needs



This slide should be incorporated into Level 2 training, before slide 21. It highlights how research shows that assumptions can be made about the behaviour of children with complex needs with the result that the possibility of their experience of adversity or trauma not being considered. We need to be particularly tuned into vulnerable children and to try to understand the meaning behind any behaviour, as all behaviour is communication and it may be the language of trauma.
